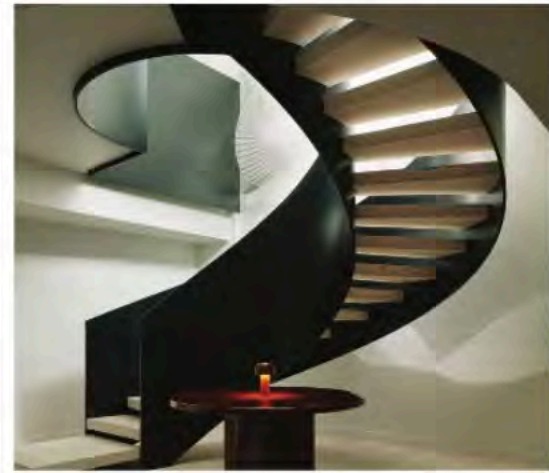

Penthouse at Television Centre

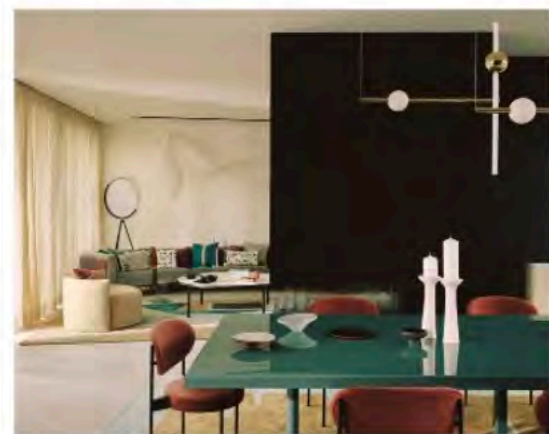
LONDON, ENGLAND

Television Centre is a cultural icon and a landmark piece of modern architecture. Beautifully restored to its former glory and now reopened to the public, this development boasts a stunning array of new homes for sale.

The Grade II listed Helios building has been converted into apartments and a new Crescent building designed by award-winning architects AHMM built to compliment it. A stunning landscaped garden offers a tranquil oasis from the bustle of the famous forecourt, with its tiered landscaping and al fresco dining.

Beneath the Helios, in the old BBC archives, an incredible new 25,000 sq. ft. gym has been opened by Soho House. Residents benefit from access to the gym, a 24 hour concierge, and a private cinema, lounge and lobby.

Villa Altoviti

PROVINCE OF FIRENZE, TUSCANY, ITALY

Villa Altoviti is a spectacular free standing five-star property full of natural light tucked away in the Florentine Chianti Hills only a thirty-minute drive from Florence.

The 560 sq. mtr. property has been very recently restored to an extremely high standard by an Italian architect and his Australian wife. With contemporary classic chic interiors, the villa presents itself with a perfect floor plan. An impressive front terrace leads up to the double doored entrance which opens up into a spacious light filled stairwell and original stone staircase.

The ground floor and principal living area intuitively flow from one space to the next. An impressive double lounge sitting room with fireplace leads to a separate dining room and wonderful huge gourmet

kitchen with travertine benches and island, and a second casual dining area. This entire space has a series of French doors which all open up onto a massive paved area for outdoor entertainment separated by a perfectly manicured lawn from the contemporary wet edge grey saltwater infinity pool.

The home has five completely private double bedroom suites each with its own ensuite marble bathroom and built in wardrobes. There is also a separate library room, a full laundry, walk in pantry and independent bathroom. Fully ducted air conditioning completes the property along with full security, a double drive entrance, impressive iron electric gates and a grove of 120 olive trees.

Musee Rodin

PARIS, FRANCE

A stone's throw from the Rodin Museum and the Matignon Hotel, this Parisian apartment is located at a remarkable and highly prized address in the 7th arrondissement. Situated on the noble floor, it is accessible by lift from an old mansion. The dwelling consists of an entrance opening onto a magnificent living room, a dining room and an office. On the courtyard, two suites include a master bedroom with bathroom and dressing room on the mezzanine. The apartment has been completely renovated with original elements preserved such as the moldings, parquet, fireplace and more.
